



Answers to the trivia questions:

- 1. The Antarctic Blue Whale is the biggest animal on the planet weighing up to 400,000 pounds (approximately 33 times an elephant's weight) and reaching up to 98 feet in length.
- 2. Banded armadillos nearly always have litters of four babies, identical quadruplets.
- 3. Have you ever seen a giraffe at the Zoo? Well, a giraffe is around the same height as a Tyrannosaurus Rex (T-REX) was!
- 4. ULUGHBEGASAURUS, the newly identified dinosaur that dwarfed early T-REX ancestors and reigned as an apex predator 90 million years ago.
- 5. Snails have microscopic teeth called 'radula' that are arranged in rows on their tongue, similar to sharks.
- 6. In weight, elephants dominate weighing 12,000 pounds or 6 tons, while an adult male giraffe weight 2,600 pounds, or about 1 1/2 tons.
- Aphids, tiny insects found the world over 'are essentially born pregnant'.
- 8. Yes, but don't worry about catching her cold. She's just sneezing from her substrate being changed out and her cloudy eyes are from being close to shedding!
- 9. Seahorses and Sea Dragons are the only species of males who give birth to live young.
- 10. Frogs incubate their eggs in their mouths, and when they ready to hatch they release the tadpoles through their mouth above the water.
